



THE GREAT PURSUIT: **IMPACTING LOSTNESS TOGETHER** Through Prayer and Giving to the **Lottie Moon Christmas Offering**

What is the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering? Southern Baptist collect an offering each year to support our international missionaries placed strategically by the International Missions Board (IMB) to further their work around the globe.

Why is it called the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering? Lottie Moon was a pioneer missionary appointed in 1873 to China's Shantung province, where she served 39 years. Although she taught and ministered far away from her Virginia roots, she advocated tirelessly for others to go, give, and pray for lost people around the world.

How is the offering used? Over 4.6 billion people are considered unreached. Over 90% of IMB teams actively engage at least one unreached people or place. One hundred percent of this offering directly supports our missionaries, and their ministry overseas, as they work to impact lostness.

How can we help? Attend the adult International Missions program on Wednesday, November 20, at 6:00 pm, to learn more about Southern Baptists' ministry in Central Asia. We will have a time of information sharing and praying, concerning issues and spiritual needs in this volatile area of the world.


